7:15-7:45 Treasurer's Report/Finance Committee

- Income \$1,319.88 from hot lunch
- Report below
- Bingos in order to get on the waitlist the SAC has to provide bylaws/constitution, what the funds will go to, and a few other paperwork items, the commitment requires 2 volunteers for 2 hour shifts, twice a month, 22 sessions per year, required to do some clean up and customer service duties, shifts may vary, can make \$1200 to \$1400 per shift, very profitable, Mark will submit the paperwork asap, when given shift schedule it is for the year, extra shifts can be picked up, volunteers have to do ½ hour of online training
- Finance Committee online meeting to discuss a few outstanding items, the committee voted on funding increases for the mural and granted \$300, SAC Admin funding of \$500 (for printer/supplies) was granted, Student funding increase from \$5 to \$6, Learning Commons was granted an additional \$1000, Recess Toys increased by \$1000 Mark motioned to pass the additional budget items, seconded by Kimberly, 16 for, 2 against passed
